Addressing Sexual Issues in Clinical Work

This workshop is an introductory look at addressing sexual issues in clinical work, providing a broad overview of the most common sexual concerns that clients can bring to treatment, how these issues intersect with other mental health concerns, and ways treatment providers can support clients in achieving psychosexual integration. It seeks to empower treatment providers to invite dialogue about sexual concerns with clients and support them in contextualizing these issues within the client's broader biopsychosocial landscape. Attendees will learn how to clearly define presenting issues, ask appropriate assessment questions, and offer relevant treatment options if the client is willing to explore and address their sexual health concerns/goals.

Learning Outcomes: At the end of this presentation, attendees will be able to:

1. Identify competing cultural messages that clients and treatment providers receive about sex and how they can impact client rapport.
2. Define at least two common sexual dysfunctions for both men and women and describe how they relate to broader biopsychosocial concerns.
3. Describe the role of mindfulness in developing healthy sexuality.

Introduction to Sex, Love, & Pornography Addiction

This workshop is an introductory look at the concepts and treatment of compulsive sexual and romantic behavior. It provides an overview of how these behaviors, also known as sex, love, and porn addiction, present in clients, useful assessment tools for treatment providers, and recommended treatment and resources for clients and providers. It seeks to empower treatment providers to understand and contextualize these issues within the client's broader biopsychosocial landscape and provide clinically appropriate guidance, support, and referrals when needed.

Learning Outcomes: At the end of this presentation, attendees will be able to:

1. Define sex, love, and porn addiction and describe typical compulsive behaviors associated with each.
2. Describe the assessment process for compulsive sexual and romantic behaviors and the similarities and differences between assessment for sex, love, and porn addiction and assessment for other behavioral and substance addictions.
3. Identify at least three supportive resources available to clients struggling with compulsive sexual and romantic behavior.
