TITLE: Multidisciplinary Approaches to Chronic Disease Care Coordination

This presentation will define multidisciplinary care and identify key roles of healthcare professionals in chronic disease care coordination. We will explore communication techniques, decision-making processes, and the role of health information technology in chronic disease coordination. We will discuss the various multidisciplinary care models to optimize team performance and patient outcomes.

TITLE: Management of Industrial Spine Injuries

It will also highlight the significance of referring patients to spine surgeons with a proven track record of successful procedures and strong clinical outcomes.
